Scott Waddle, retired Commander & Captain of the USS GREENVILLE, Speaker at 9th Annual CMHC Business Breakfast Event


(Torrington, CT) – Scott Waddle, retired Commander and Captain of the USS GREENVILLE, spoke on Thursday, May 16, 2019 to a group of local bankers, business people and elected officials at the 9th Annual Connecticut Mutual Holding Company Business Breakfast held at Chatterley’s Banquet Facility in Torrington.

Scott Waddle entertained the audience by telling the story of what took place during the tragic accident at sea, when the USS GREENVILLE collided with the Japanese fishing training vessel, Ehime Maru. The accident sunk the vessel in three minutes and killed nine onboard. The audience was captivated by Scott’s story of honesty, strength and integrity as he took sole responsibility of his actions and the actions of his crew. The presentation was intense, filled with emotions - laughter to tears - as stories were told of Scott’s acceptance into the Navy, his journey, his failures, his family life and the leadership lessons learned after that tragic date back in February 2001.
